Archbishop of Canterbury Dr. Rowan Williams

104th bishop of the See of Canterbury: the first Welsh successor to St Augustine of Canterbury and the first since the mid-thirteenth century to be appointed from beyond the English Church.

Dr. Williams is acknowledged internationally as an outstanding theological writer, scholar and teacher.

Barenboym Peter

President of the "Florentine Society" in Moscow, lawyer, Vice President of the Federal Union of Lawyers of Russia, human rights activist, author of a wide spectrum of books and publications dedicated to the problems of history and development of civil society in Europe and Russia.

Borshchevsky Michael

Publisher and Editor-in-Chief of "Herald of Europe", Professor of Westminster University, member of the Editorial Board of "Vestnik Evropy".

Chistyakov Georgy (1953-2007)

Priest in the Church of Saints Cosmas and Damian in Shubino (Moscow), philologist, theologian, historian, follower of Alexander Men, spiritual leader of the Charity Group named after Alexander Men, Father Dean of the Church of Intercession of the Holy Virgin Mary at the Russian Children's Hospital, author of several books, translations, and numerous periodical articles.

Gaidar Yegor (1956-2009)

Doctor of Science (Economics), Director of the Institute of the Economy in Transition, Former Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Economics and Finance of Russian Federation, Honorary Professor of University of California (Berkeley, USA), Member of the Editorial Boards of "Herald of Europe" and "Vestnik Evropy" since the establishment of the magazines, author of more than 100 publications and several books.

Genieva Ekaterina

Director General of the all-Russia State Library of Foreign Literature, PhD in philology (Moscow University, 1971), author of numerous publications on Russian, English, and Irish literature, Vice President of Russian Association of Libraries, Member of Council of Russian Bible Society, Council Member of the all-Russian Foundation for Culture, Observer of the Russo-German library commission on restitution, Vice President of the International Federation of Library Associations and Organizations, Member of the editorial council of the international Herald Spoils of War, Member of international bureau of UNESCO. Presented with the award of Peoples Friendship and many medals.

Gordin Jacob

Russian historian, essay writer, literature expert; together with Andrei Arieiev is the Editor-in-Chief of "Zvezda" magazine.

Janouch Frantisek

Czech physicist, dissident, active participant of the events of the "Prague Spring"; author of books and articles dedicated to this topic.

Mau Vladimir

Doctor of Economic Sciences, Rector of the Academy of National Economy, Editor-in-Chief of the magazine "Economic Policy"

Pomeranz Grigory

Philosopher, culturologist and publicist; author of numerous philosophical works that circulated in samizdat and made a great impact on the views of liberal intelligentsia in the 60-s and 70-s.

Portes Richard

Professor of Economics at London Business School, Founder and President of the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR), Directeur d'Etudes at the Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales, Senior Editor and Co-Chairman of the Board of Economic Policy.

Rashkovsky Yevgeny

Professor, Head of the Research Department of Religious Literature and Russian Publications Abroad at the State Library of Foreign Literature in Moscow, author of books on history of religion and culture.

Shelov-Kovedyaev Fyodor

Professor of the Department of World Economics and Politics at the Higher School of Economics, in 1991-1992 First Deputy of the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Russia.

Turmaine Simon

Simon Turmaine was born in the North of England in 1962. He now lives near London and works in the risk control industry.

Wadsworth William

Poet, Executive Director of The Academy of American Poets from 1989 to 2001, creator of the award-winning website Poets.org, special consultant to the Joseph Brodsky Memorial Fellowship Fund, Professor of the Columbia University and Purchase College, Contributing editor of Tin House and The Paris Review, member of the advisory boards of The Frost Place, Parnassus: Poetry in Review, and Archipelago Press.
