



“BIBLICAL HILLS”

OF IRINA STARZHENETSKAYA

Irina Starzhenetskaya – artist, Active member of the Russian Academy of Arts, laureate of the State Prize of Russia, author of hundreds of paintings, frescoed several Orthodox cathedrals in Moscow and Tarus. Last year I.Starzhenetskaya published two albums and organized two exhibitions inspired by the Old Testament books.

In March 2010 Irina Starzhenetskaya presented a series of paintings and an album under the title “Biblical Hills” (tempera on paper, 2009-2010) in the gallery M’ARS in Moscow. The exhibition consisted of three parts: “The Book of Ruth”, “Solomon’s Song of Songs”, and “Presaging the Gospels”. In July 2010 at the exhibition in the Academy of Arts in Moscow Irina Starzhenetskaya displayed her new album “The Book of Genesis” based on the translations by Griliches. Using the artistic experience of the early Christianity, I.Starzhenetskaya found her own deep and expressive way of interpreting the Biblical History. “Biblical Hills” and “The Beginning of Time” is the unique expression of the modern artistic interpretation of the Scripture.
